



## About the Department

The Aging & Disabilities (AD) Department serves the growing population of older adults, dependent adults, and individuals with disabilities in Los Angeles County. The department offers a broad range of services aimed at fostering dignity, independence, and overall well-being. Through compassionate and intentional support, AD ensures that individuals can live fulfilling lives within their communities, maintaining the highest quality of life possible.

## Main Services

### ● Older Adult Services

The Department provides a wide range of services designed to enhance the health, and quality of life for older adults in the Los Angeles Region. Key programs include the **Elderly Nutrition Program (ENP)**, **Home-Delivered Meals**, **Emergency Food Assistance (Pantry) Program**, **Family Caregiver Support Program (FCSP)**, and others. These services focus on supporting older adults in maintaining autonomy and well-being.

### ● Community & Senior Centers

Los Angeles County's Community & Senior Centers offer diverse services and activities aimed at fostering community engagement and well-being. These centers provide opportunities for learning, skills development, socialization, and healthy living for residents of all ages, enhancing the quality of life for participants.

### ● Disabilities Services

AD offers a variety of programs to support individuals with disabilities and their caregivers, including **Information & Assistance**, which connects people to resources; **Outreach**, raising awareness through community events and partnerships; **L.A. Found**, providing tracking devices for individuals with cognitive impairments; and **New Freedom Transportation**, offering enhanced options such as volunteer driver reimbursement and taxicab services.

### ● Adult Protective Services (APS)

Adult Protective Services is a program **available 24/7**, required by the state to investigate situations involving older adults (60 years and older) and dependent adults (18-59 who are physically and/or mentally impaired) if they are believed to be in danger due to physical, sexual, financial abuse, isolation, neglect, self-neglect, or at risk of homelessness. APS provides services and supports through action, compassion, and intention.
